When you apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, you may also request and receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee from University of Alaska Fairbanks, College of Engineering and Mines – even before you leave your home country!

HERE'S HOW EASY IT IS!

- 1 Apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, indicating your transfer preference to University of Alaska Fairbanks, College of Engineering and Mines on your application.
- 2 Receive your acceptance letter from Seattle Colleges, and a conditional letter of admission from University of Alaska Fairbanks, College of Engineering and Mines at the same time.
- 3 Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4 Complete the first two years of your Bachelor's degree at Seattle Colleges by getting an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree, completing the required SCD courses for the UAF program.
- 5 Transfer to University of Alaska Fairbanks to complete the last two years of your Bachelor's degree.
- 6 Graduate and receive your Bachelor's degree from University of Alaska Fairbanks!

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS FOR UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA FAIRBANKS, COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND MINES:

- 1 Complete an approved transferable Associate of Science (A.S.) degree at Seattle Colleges, including the Engineering courses required for the UAF degree program (consult with your academic advisor upon enrollment at Seattle Colleges for a complete list).
- 2 Submit an approved form of proof of English Proficiency, e.g., completion of ENGL& 101 with a grade of at least 2.00, official TOEFL iBT score of 79 and above, or an IELTS score of 6.5 and above.
- 3 Earn a minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average on all transferable credit classes from Seattle Colleges and previous institutions.
- 4 Submit an admission application online at <https://uaonline.alaska.edu>. Note that the University of Alaska Fairbanks will waive its \$50 application fee for all Seattle Colleges students who have a transfer admission guarantee letter.
- 5 Send official copies of all transcripts, financial statement, and supporting documentation to the UAF Office of Admissions.
- 6 Adhere to University of Alaska Fairbanks' deadlines for application and document submission, and admission policies.
- 7 Upon admission, submit all required documents for F1 student status and SEVIS transfer.
